#### Søren Østergaard

Head of Center for Youth Studies (CUR), author and speaker.

Søren Østergaard has since 1995 primarily researched the lives and values of children and young people, their participation in leisure and association life, their adult relations, and well-being. He has written a large number of books about children and youth - of which are mentioned: "Good sports environments for girls" (2018), "Boys we must stick together otherwise we will be honored - about tweens, well-being and communities" (2018), "Young people in a performance culture "(2016).

Dennis Fabian is responsible for strings, machines, accesories, custom made racquets and tennis sensor at HEAD since 2017. He's been in the Tennis Industry for 10 years working for PRINCE and has worked as a Tennis Coach for 8 years. He has played tennis since 6 years old and started stringing being 12 years old.

#### Richard Parnell ERSA Master PTS (Master Pro Tour Stringer), HEAD.

Richard Parnell has been a professional stringer since 1992, has collaborated with the most important stringing teams worldwide (HEAD, Babolat, Tecnifibre, Wilson, Yonex) and for many years worked with the LTA at their senior training camps (stringing and frame customisation) at the La Manga Resort, Murcia. The Parnell Knot (Richard's signature knot) is one of two official knots authorised at Wimbledon and teh official knot of the Madrid Open Head Stringing Team.



Director of inspire2coach, international speaker and concultant, LTA Level 5 coach and Master Coach Education Tutor.

Mark has more than 25 years' experience coaching in clubs and tennis centres in the UK, specialising in particular in coaching starter players. He has been training coaches for the LTA and ITF for over 15 years, and has tutored over 100 ceertification courses in the UK. Mark was heavily involved in the development and launch of the ITF Tennis Play

and Stay campaign, and he was heavily involved in the writing of the ITF Tennis Play and Stay manual and the Tennis Xpress programme for beginner adults. Mark has presented at conferences and workshops in over 90 countries and is a regular visitor to Scandinavia and the Baltic region.

#### **David Gustafsson**

Sports Director of Fair Play Tennisclub Malmø, Sweden.

Sports Director at Fair Play Tennisclub since 2018. Before that, he was club director in Höllvikens Tennisklubb for 10 years. David has also worked with the Swedish Tennis Federation, and Tennis Syd, where he has over 12 years of experience of educating coaches for primarily kids 5-12 years old. David has a tennis background competing on a national level in juniors, and in college where he also rece

Fair Play Tennisclub is currently the biggest club in Sweden with approximately 3.000 members, and around 1.650 players of all ages that comes to practice in Swedens largest tennisschool every week.
